Seminars

As well as the main meetings there will be a selection of seminars on Saturday and Sunday, led by Kenny and his wife, Morag, as well as some of our local church leaders. There are also youth-oriented worship bands for the kids and teens groups, led by young talented musicians from local churches. Costs

Whether you are able to come for the whole weekend, one day or just one Sunday service you are very welcome! The following charges apply as appropriate. Child rates apply for ages reception to 14 (under 4's are exempt).

Weekend pass: £25 per adult, £12.50 per child covers both days.

Day pass: For people who can only come for one full day (Saturday or Sunday), day passes can be bought at £15 per adult, £7.50 per child.

Family Pass: a family pass can be bought for £60. Family passes cover the entire weekend.

Early booking discount: Register before 1st April and receive a 20% discount!

Sunday offerings: Offerings will be taken at both Sunday morning and evening services to help cover the costs of the weekend and towards ongoing investment into New Wine initiatives in Guernsey.
