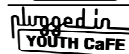

Remembrance Sunday

On my last visit to Sark, to say Mass for the small Catholic community on the island, I was required to take the early morning 8 o'clock boat. This meant that I had plenty of time, after my 'choppy' crossing, to prepare for Mass at 12 o'clock. I ambled slowly along to Saint Peter's Anglican church, where we celebrate the Sacred Liturgy each month, and took time to examine the beautiful windows of the church. They really are magnificent and tell you so much about those who lived and worshipped God there. One window, in particular, drew my attention. It was that which honoured those who had given their lives in the First World War. The names of each of the fallen soldiers from Sark was given on the edge of the glass, with the date on which they had entered eternal life. Their collective sacrifice was thus punctuated by the successive years of the war recorded from the earliest days at the top of the window to the last days at the bottom. As I considered the information before me, I realized that the last soldier named had died a few days after the ending of hostilities. Having out-lived the war itself, this poor man was robbed of life by the consequences of the war that had been waged.

Such cruel loss of life drives home to us the sacrifice of all those who gave themselves in order that subsequent generations might be free. Each year, we promise to remember the fallen and, indeed, we do. Yet, perhaps as an examination of conscience, we should ask ourselves whether we have used the freedom gained in a way that is truly worthy of their memory and the sacrifice made. For failures in this regard, both on an individual level and as a society, we should ask God's forgiveness. Great was the price paid that we might be free.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.
