Ten things to consider praying for as the States debate the 'modernisation' of Guernsey's Abortion Law

- 1. Pray that the value and inherent dignity of all in our society may be promoted, whether that be women, unborn babies or those with disabilities.
- 2. Pray for clarity over the legal status and rights of every unborn child in the womb.
- 3. Pray for understanding among our Deputies of the issues involved, and an openness to engage in debate with respect and humility. Pray for those with pro-life views that they would be given courage and wisdom to speak and contribute meaningfully to the debate. Pray for those who are undecided, that the debate may persuade them to vote against this change in the law.
- 4. Pray for Maria O'Brien and the campaign 'both lives matter', that this may be effective and conducted in a Christ-like way.
- 5. Pray that many people will be stirred to speak or write to their Deputies about this issue.
- 6. Pray that media coverage may be balanced, and that the views of the 'both lives matter' campaign may be fairly represented.
- 7. Pray for the preservation of safeguards for medical practitioners with conscientious objections to abortion.
- 8. Pray that a better way than abortion may emerge that truly supports women on our Island in unplanned pregnancies.
- 9. Pray that there would be appropriate support and care for women on our Island who have had an abortion.
- 10. Pray that the strong case against changing the law may be made and heard, and that this proposal may be deferred or defeated.
